

# Regulatory certainty





- MP/Kigali: When fully implemented: Average GWP of 300 to 400;
- EU/f-gas revision: Full HFC phase-out and equipment prohibitions;
- (PFAS);
- Future will only allow for natural refrigerants and maybe a few others.

## Cold chain and MLF













### Current MLF framework




- Financial support to phase-out ODS;
- Cost effectiveness \$\$/kg phased out;
- Eligibility: Baseline and year of installation;
- Support to manufacturing sector and service sector;
- Many cold chain applications fall outside so-called assembly sector;
- End-user projects subjected to strict reporting and substantial cofinancing;

### Future MLF framework



- Assembly sector may be significant for HFC phase-down (data needed);
- Indications of willingness to increase funding levels;
- Policies are being discussed;
- Suggested activities:
  - Assessment of product, component and skills available in a country;
  - Technical assistance to develop products with low- or no GWP possible;
  - Provision of equipment needed, e.g. for handling of flammable refrigerants;
  - Technology demonstration(s) of local technical solutions;
  - Awareness raising to end-users.
